5440 HONORING PUPIL ACHIEVEMENT

The Board of Education values excellence and wishes to inculcate in students the desire to do their best in all things. It shall be the policy of this Board, therefore, to recognize outstanding academic achievement.

The Board authorizes the award of academic achievement certificates to students in sixth grade and above beginning in the 2013-2014 school year in recognition of the following academic achievements:

 - a. A minimum of "B" grades in all core subjects,
 - b. "A", "B", consistent competence or steady growth in all special subject disciplines, and
 - c. "3" or "4" in all attributes.

B. Final Annual Academic Recognition

- 1. Annual High Academic Achievers Students who achieve high "academic achiever" status for all marking periods.
- 2. Annual Academic Achievers Students who achieve "academic achiever" status for all marking periods.
