

5830 PUPIL FUND RAISING

The Board of Education will limit fund-raising by the pupils of this district in order to protect pupils from unnecessary pressures and the instructional program from disruption. Pupil fund-raising may only occur under the direct supervision of adults.

“Pupil fund raising” means the solicitation and collection of money by pupils, on or off school premises, for any purpose associated directly or indirectly with the school district or under circumstances in which the solicitors are identified as pupils of this district.

Activities that include family or student incentives as a reward for pupil fund-raising will not be permitted. The Board will not support any fund-raising activities that promote student door-to-door solicitation. In situations in which order forms are sent home with students, the school will send home a letter that reiterates the message that the fund-raising activity is the responsibility of the parent. Merchandise that is purchased as a result of a fund-raiser must be picked up by parents with a reminder that door-to-door delivery by students is not to occur.

Fund-raising by approved school organizations may occur providing the fund-raising has been approved by the Superintendent or his/her designee. At the beginning of each school year a list of fund-raising activities may be submitted by each school organization to the Superintendent or his/her designee for prior approval.

No pupil will be permitted to solicit and collect money on school premises or at a school-sponsored event for the pupil’s own benefit.
