Loitering on Property of the Board of Education

7440.1 LOITERING ON PROPERTY OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

No person shall loiter, or assemble with others, on property owned by or under the control of the Howell Township Board of Education so as to:

1. Create or cause to be created an immediate actual, physical violent reaction causing a threat to the peace and order of an individual or individuals or the operation of the schools;
2. Disturb a person of ordinary sensibilities so as to cause such person to react immediately in such a way as to threaten by physical violence the peace and order of the public schools under the control of the Howell Township Board of Education;
3. Obstruct the free passage of pedestrians or vehicles;
4. Obstruct, molest, or interfere with any person lawfully on or about school owned or controlled property.

This paragraph shall include the making of unsolicited remarks of an offensive, disgusting or insulting nature or which are calculated to annoy or disturb the person to, or in whose hearing, they are made, so as to cause such person to react immediately in such a way as to threaten by physical violence the peace and order of the operation of the school system;

5. Cause damage or malicious mischief to the property of the Howell Township Board of Education, or
6. Refuse to leave property owned by or under the control of the Howell Township Board of Education after being directed to do so by a police officer or any employee or agent of the Howell Township Board of Education.

For the purposes of this policy the term loitering shall mean remaining idle in essentially one location and shall include the concepts of spending time in idleness, loafing or walking about aimlessly and shall also include the colloquial expression "hanging around."
