

9500 RELATIONS WITH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

It is the policy of the Board of Education that strong lines of communication be maintained by the district with other districts and institutions which provide programs, training, or services not available to children residing in this district.

This Board will attempt to meet periodically with the governing board of the educational institution which receives from this district a significant number of pupils. In order to maintain cordial and constructive relationships with such other educational institutions, the Superintendent shall -

A. In the Case of the High School

1. Cooperate with the professional staff in articulation studies to insure that pupils of this district are properly prepared to enter the schools of the receiving district;
2. Arrange to have pupils informed during their final year in this district of program options in the receiving district and counsel them regarding their program choices; and
3. Arrange to provide an orientation program for pupils in their final year in this district and to familiarize them with the facilities, procedures and rules of the receiving district.

B. In the Case of Parochial and Private Schools

1. Maintain liaison with the administrators of all private and parochial schools which enroll significant numbers of pupils resident in this district in order to be aware of any program changes that may be planned which could affect this district; and
2. Cooperate fully in the implementation of all State and Federal programs administered by this district which benefit in whole or in part, eligible pupils attending private or parochial school.

C. In the Case of Institutions of Higher Education

1. Cooperate with State institutions in the placement and evaluation of practice teachers in accordance with Board policy on student teachers.
