# HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR KINDERGARTENENTRANCE

- <u>DTP</u>: 4 DOSES WITH ONE DOSE GIVEN ON OR AFTER THE 4<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY, <u>OR</u> ANY 5 DOSES
- <u>POLIO</u>: 3 DOSES, WITH ONE DOSE GIVEN ON OR AFTER THE 4<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY <u>OR</u> ANY 4 DOSES
- MEASLES: 2 DOSES OF A LIVE MEASLES CONTAINING VACCINE ON OR AFTER 1<sup>ST</sup> BIRTHDAY
- <u>RUBELLA:</u> 1 DOSE OF A LIVE RUBELLA CONTAINING VACCINE ON OR AFTER 1<sup>ST</sup> BIRTHDAY
- <u>MUMPS:</u> 1 DOSE OF A LIVE MUMPS CONTAINING VACCINE ON OR AFTER 1<sup>ST</sup> BIRTHDAY

VARICELLA (CHICKEN POX): 1 DOSE ON OR AFTER 1<sup>ST</sup> BIRTHDAY

HEPATITIS B: 3 DOSES PRIOR TO SCHOOL ENTRANCE

PHYSICAL EXAM: SHOULD BE DATED AFTER SEPTEMBER 1, 2018

MANTOUX SKIN TEST: PLEASE SEE ATTACHED INFO

In order for your child to attend school in September, you must provide any Health Requirements not submitted at the time of your child's registration to your child's School Nurse prior to September 1. If your child's birthdate precludes him/her from receiving the necessary Health Requirements prior to September 1, please contact your child's School Nurse.

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## **Required Tuberculosis Testing in New Jersey Schools for 2019/2020**

Justification: To restrict tuberculin skin test screening in New Jersey schools to teachers/other employees and only those students who are at highest risk for latent TB infection.

- I. Only a positive interferon gamma release assay test (IGRA) result or a Mantoux intradermal test using 5 TU of stabilized PPD tuberculin skin test result measuring  $\geq$  10mm of induration shall be considered a "significant reaction".
- II. The following tuberculin skin testing requirements apply to <u>ALL</u> school districts:
  - 1. Students born in a country that is not listed on page 3 and entering school in the U.S. for the first time, regardless of age or grade.
  - 2. Students transferring into the New Jersey school system directly from a country not listed on page 3, regardless of age or grade.

### **EXCEPTIONS FOR BOTH GROUPS OF STUDENTS LISTED ABOVE:**

**Entering at preschool through 5**: Tuberculin skin testing is not required if the student has documentation of an IGRA or a Mantoux tuberculin skin test at the age of <u>three years</u> or older, regardless of the result of that skin test.

**Entering at grades 6 through 12**: Tuberculin skin testing is not required if the student has documentation of a negative tuberculosis test in the last six months or a positive skin test, regardless when this test was done.

Tuberculin skin testing is not required if the student has attended school in another state prior to entering the New Jersey school system.

Any student with parents claiming religious exemption cannot be compelled to submit to tuberculin skin testing. In these instances, a symptom assessment must be done. If TB-like symptoms are reported, a physician must document that the student does not have active disease. Please contact your school nurse for necessary forms.
